SGN are in agreement with the proposer of the Modification Proposal that, considering the economic climate has not improved, this change originally brought about by UNC MOD 0275 is still warranted.

Concerns were raised during the UNC MOD 0275 consultation in relation to Shippers potentially abusing this process to artificially reduce their costs by reducing their Supply Point Capacity (SOQ), but as there has been no evidence of this for the past two years and we do not consider this to be a valid issue.

We do recognise that there may only be a very modest uptake of this service but do not think this should impede implementation due to the support that this service could potentially offer to businesses and hence UK Plc. We would however request that shippers utilising this process during the Capacity Reduction Period be mindful of the importance of the Supply Point Offtake Rate (SHQ) to Transporter network and capacity planning and wherever possible look to amend this value alongside the Supply Point Capacity (SOQ).

There should also be further consideration given to an ongoing solution in this area and SGN would support a review of the potential options.
