The removal of the Bottom Stop Supply Point Capacity which is linked to the previous winter's peak day consumption has the potential to cause financial difficulty to customers during reduced periods of economic activity. By removing the Bottom Stop Supply Point Capacity and allowing capacity to be booked that is more reflective of actual use, the industry will benefit from the correct allocation of capacity which will help facilitate effective competition between shippers.
