UNC Modification 279 provided shippers with increased visibility of meter read history and meter asset information for meter points which were new to their portfolio and has enabled a more thorough and effective AQ Review process. More accurate AQs lead to a more accurate allocation of transportation charges and energy and therefore help facilitate competition between shippers. This modification extends this by providing this information on a more frequent basis.

The information within the reports contributes to a more thorough and accurate AQ Review process being undertaken by shippers which in turn leads to the improved allocation of transportation charges. By providing this information on a regular basis throughout the year, rather than just at one point annually, shippers are not restricted in the information that is made available to them depending on when they gain a supply point. This removes an inequity between incumbent and incoming shippers and helps to secure effective competition between relevant shippers and suppliers (Relevant Objective c).
