The MOD186 report, presented through the Distribution Charging Managers Forum (DCMF), allows Shippers to understand likely future charges and their effect on the customer bill. The current timing of this publication results in information potentially becoming quickly outdated as assumptions crystalise shortly after publication. Significant assumptions which crystalise shortly after publication currently include:

- MODt adjustment published in November
- 2. HMRC Inflation figures in November
- 3. Final Pricing Statements in January

Any significant movement from assumed values would not be communicated to shippers until the next quarterly report.

By changing the publication dates (and associated GDN/Shipper meeting dates) it would result in fewer assumptions having to be made, resulting in:

- Less time needed explaining variations between assumed and actual figures at DCMF and in the MOD186 report
- Reduction in movements between subsequent publications
- Increased consistency where each GDN may use different assumptions to forecast unknown variables.
