This modification gives permission for Transporters to release the identity of the Supplier for a single Supply Point in response to a request from the Energy Theft Tip off Line (ETTOS) service provider. This modification meets the requirements of the ETTOS in a proportionate way and we therefore support it. With regard to relevant objectives as the ETTOS is a service provided to Suppliers and Transporters, we see the primary benefit is to Suppliers and the efficient provision of the service enabled by this modification (relevant objective (f)) will assist in tackling theft thereby securing effective competition between Suppliers (relevant objective (d) i). We cannot see a direct benefit to Shippers under relevant objective (d) ii.
