Please summarise (in one paragraph) the key reason(s) for your support/opposition.

The modification identifies that there are currently some 6.2 million Supply Points for which the Market Sector Code (MSC) is blank in the central systems. It goes on to say that on the current rate of progress it would take to 2018 to be largely resolved. Shippers could send in a T73 flow providing the MSC to resolve this situation. However for the number of Supply Points in question Shippers might not wish to do this manually, but an IT solution would take time to put in place. The proposal goes on to say that if after the 6 month transition period the blank MSC field is not resolved Xoserve could populate this field under User Pays. It would seem sensible to understand now on what basis Xoserve would carry out this exercise, to see if it was appropriate and then Shippers could determine whether it would be more cost effective to go straight to this option. Each Shipper would need to be advised of the number of blank MSC's in its portfolio.
