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Ofgem Security of Supply SCR – Cash Out Reform and Compensation Arrangements

Change Overview

- Ofgem's final decision for the Gas Significant Code Review (SCR) was published on the 23rd September 2014. This documented the changes required to the Gas Deficit Emergency (GDE) Cashout arrangements and the introduction of arrangements that recompense End Consumers for involuntary demand-side interruption of supply during a GDE
- Ofgem is using its powers under the Gas Act to direct changes to the UNC and is looking for the changes to be implemented by 1st October 2015
- To support the requirements of the GDE Cashout arrangements, Xoserve is developing a solution to calculate the charges for MPRNs that are eligible for compensation as a result of a Gas supply emergency

 - TSS – Targeting short Shippers for DSR fund imbalance
 - DSP – Initial and revised DSR payment for the volume of demand curtailed
