

Self-Governance Statement

0386: Extending rights to Protected Information provisions for Meter Asset Managers/Registered Metering Applicants – unpopulated MAM id records

The Transporters are submitting this Self-Governance Statement to the Authority in accordance with the UNC Modification Rules.

On 16 June 2011, the Modification Panel considered Modification 0386 and determined (by unanimous vote) that the modification should be treated as a Self-Governance Modification Proposal, as it was felt that the proposed change would simplify and make more efficient the process by which data can be accessed and so can be updated on central systems. As such, the modification:

- (i) is unlikely to have a material effect on:
 - (aa) existing or future gas consumers; and
 - (bb) competition in the shipping, transportation or supply of gas conveyed through pipes or any commercial activities connected with the shipping, transportation or supply of gas conveyed through pipes; and
 - (cc) the operation of one or more pipe-line system(s); and
 - (dd) matters relating to sustainable development, safety or security of supply, or the management of market or network emergencies; and
 - (ee) the uniform network code governance procedures or the network code modification procedures; and
- (ii) is unlikely to discriminate between different classes of parties to the uniform network code/relevant gas transporters, gas shippers or DN operators.

The Proposed Self-Governance Modification Proposal Determination Date is 15 September 2011.
