

Self-Governance Statement

0406S: Changes to the Measurement Provisions of the px (TGPP) Limited Network Entry Agreement (NEA)

The Transporters are submitting this Self-Governance Statement to the Authority in accordance with the UNC Modification Rules.

On 15 December 2011, the Modification Panel considered Modification 0406 and determined **by unanimous vote** that the modification should be treated as a Self-Governance Modification Proposal as it is a facilitating modification, which allows changes to be made to the Network Entry Agreement (NEA). This would facilitate the NEA being amended to reflect revised metering arrangements and, as such, would have no material impact on competition nor on consumers.

As such, the modification:

- (i) is unlikely to have a material effect on:
 - (aa) existing or future gas consumers; and
 - (bb) competition in the shipping, transportation or supply of gas conveyed through pipes or any commercial activities connected with the shipping, transportation or supply of gas conveyed through pipes; and
 - (cc) the operation of one or more pipe-line system(s); and
 - (dd) matters relating to sustainable development, safety or security of supply, or the management of market or network emergencies; and
 - (ee) the uniform network code governance procedures or the network code modification procedures; and
- (ii) is unlikely to discriminate between different classes of parties to the uniform network code/relevant gas transporters, gas shippers or DN operators.

The Proposed Self-Governance Modification Proposal Determination Date is **16 February 2012**.
