

- Development of the model itself phase 1 completed
- Development of assumptions in progress
- Running the model and analysis of outputs over the next 2-3 months
- Consultation May/June?
- Include outputs in pilot version of Gas System
 Operability Framework May/June
- Incorporate into GTYS November
