TO Entry Commodity Rebate

Following the end of the 2010/11 formula year, National Grid is in a position to finalise the calculation of the NTS TO Commodity Rebate as described in paragraph 3.2 of The Gas Transmission Transportation Charging Methodology (UNC Section Y Part A Section 1).

In the NTS Notice of Revised Gas Transmission Transportation Charges dated 1^{st} April 2011¹ we forecasted a residual TO Entry over recovery of c. £4m for the period 2010/11. However, following a warmer than expected February and March, National Grid collected less TO entry commodity income than forecast. Whilst there has been a small over-recovery on TO entry, the amount is less than the trigger for the rebate (£1m) and consequently there will be no rebate with respect to 2010/11. The total TO over-recovery will be separated into entry and exit adjustments (k-factors) according to TO entry and TO exit allowed and collected income².
