1.3 Pre Modification Discussions

1.3.1 Review of the Merit Order

CW outlined the main points on his presentation slide explaining the QSEC 2013 and 2014 analysis. CR queried the exit point figures for Pembroke which he pointed out did not represent a large increase which he was aware of. CW agreed to double check the data and publish this for all exit points shortly.

He advised that the results had led National Grid to consider raising a modification to be submitted to the October Panel.

DRe questioned the timing in view of the on-going transmission charging review and whether National Grid may wish to delay raising this modification so that any alterations subsequently found to be necessary could be taken into account. CW replied that this had been considered and no issues identified, hence progressing to a modification at this time.

LJ outlined the necessary timeline in order for the modification to be implemented in April 2015, which would require a Panel decision no later than February 2015. This meant that the workgroup report would have to be submitted to Panel in December or January.
