Background

- Annex I to Regulation (EC) No 715/2009, known as “Congestion Management Principles “ introduced a long term use it or lose it mechanism at Interconnection Points
- Mod 485 brought this into the UNC
- Required NGG to provide Ofgem with a report every 6 months

Update

- Monitoring process is now operational
- Ofgem received first report from NGG in early November
- No congestion was reported at IPs, hence no withdrawal proceedings occurring at this time

Next steps

- Monitoring process to continue
- We will not provide updates like this in the future, as there may be potential withdrawal procedures underway
