Assumptions:

- 1. Each Shipper registered to Supply Point for 4 months
- 2. No historical information available to Shippers
- **3.** All other details correct and accurate
- 4. Meter readings are available every 2 months

Potential Allocation Arrangements:

- 1. 100% Shipper C change in consumption clearly occurred in Shipper C's ownership and should have appealed AQ to avoid Mod 640 charges
- 2. 50% Shipper B 50% Shipper C change in consumption clearly occurred in Shipper B's ownership and both Shipper B and Shipper C should have appealed the AQ

- 3. Invalid query change in consumption could have occurred in Shipper A's or Shipper B's ownership. However if significant evidence to demonstrate that AQ was SSP for significant period in Shipper's A ownership potential to re-apportion with more waiting to Shipper B and C
- 4. Invalid query change in consumption occurred in Shipper A's ownership. Current charges stand
- 5. 50% Shipper B 50% Shipper C Shipper A query valid as evidence that change in AQ occurred in Shipper B's ownership. Shipper B to Shipper C query invalid as unclear when change in AQ occurred.
- 6. Invalid volatile consumption but all Shippers should have appealed AQ with information available.
- 7. Invalid query unclear when change in AQ occurred due to lack of meter readings.
