2. Recommendations from the final Delivery Sub-Committee meeting, covering PIS Exit

SM explained that, previously, the DSC Change Management Committee had asked for the Nexus Delivery Sub-Committee to report on the decision reached when asked to formally agree the closure of the Project Nexus Post Implementation Support (PIS) period. This recommendation was set out in D035 which is shown on slide 16 of the material provided and distributed earlier this week, a copy of which can be found on the Joint Office website here: https://www.gasgovernance.co.uk/DSC-Change/310817

All parties present were in agreement with the proposal to terminate the Nexus Delivery Sub Committee and that its activities would now revert to the DSC Change Management Committee. It was noted that the Defect Resolution Group (DRG) and the Data Management Group (DMG) meetings will continue and provide updates to the DSC Change Management Committee.

The DRG meets weekly and holds responsibility for coordinating management of all releases prior to release 2.0. Enduring delivery governance proposals will recommend future role.

The DMG will continue and meets on a monthly basis reporting status updates against the operational MI including the first run during PIS period. Enduring delivery governance proposals will recommend future role.

SM asked those present to note that the view from the Delivery Sub-Committee was that enduring delivery governance (for future non-Nexus changes) needed to be established but it was recognised that this would be deliberated upon by the DSC Change Management Committee at its September and October meetings.

Members noted that the Change Delivery Sub-committee would be closed down from 31 August 2017.

SM advised that concludes the update and asked if there were any questions.

When asked, SM confirmed that the DRG will continue to manage release 1.1, confirming that this has been managed effectively for the last 2 months and that it is anticipated it will run smoothly.

BV, recognising the importance of Nexus non-related issues, asked if these will go through the DSC Change Management Committee? SM advised that it is intended that proposals will be presented in Day 1 of the September 2017 DSC Change Management Committee for review and then a final set of proposals will be presented at the October 2017 DSC Change Management Committee. These proposals will also be shared with previous members of the Delivery sub-committee.

When asked, SM confirmed that it is anticipated that monthly updates for Unidentified Gas (UIG) issues will be presented to the DSC Change Management Committee.

There was agreement that the Performance Assurance Committee (PAC) is possibly a good place for discussions on UIG.
