This created a final version of the Workgroup Report that will be submitted to the October 2017 UNC Panel.

There then followed an on-screen review of the 'National Grid Gas Transmission (NGGT) Gas Quality Consultation Questions – Draft' provided by National Grid NTS for the meeting.

The Workgroup reviewed the questions and considered they are relevant in the wider context, but not for Modification 0607S.

Thank you to National Grid for sharing their intended consultation questions with the Workgroup. The Workgroup were pleased to have had the opportunity to have seen them.
