

UNC Workgroup Individual Terms of Reference

0632S - Shipper asset details reconciliation

Introduction

This is an Individual Terms of Reference that includes matters referred from Panel or identified within any initial representations. It replaces the standard Terms of Reference.

Purpose of the Modification and its Solution

It is proposed that improvements are to be made to the asset data held by Xoserve on behalf of industry parties by placing obligations in the UNC to:

- Require shippers to record whether a Smart Meter or AMR device exists at their site, and
- 2. Xoserve to report within 3 months of implementation the number of Smart Meters and AMR Devices installed on sites by each EUC band, to allow comparison with BEIS published Smart meter rollout statistics. Reports to the sent to the industry on an anonymised basis initially.

For the avoidance of doubt any process for remedying discrepancies between those being reported to BEIS and the CDSP will be up to the PAC to decide.

To produce a Workgroup Report, for submission to the UNC Modification Panel, containing the assessment and recommendation(s) of the Workgroup.
