UNC607: Amendment to Gas Quality NTS Entry Specification at the St Fergus NSMP System Entry Point

On 27 February 2018 we directed that UNC modification 607 be made. The modification proposes to implement an increase in the carbon dioxide limit within the Network Entry Agreement at the North Sea Midstream Partners sub terminal at St. Fergus between National Grid Gas plc and NSMP Ltd.

We also directed pursuant to SLC10(15) that the requirement on IUK to publish the Charging Methodology Statement 28 days prior to coming into effect be waived.
