#### 1.0 Introduction and Status Review

**1.1** Approval of Minutes (01 March 2018)

The minutes from the previous meeting were approved.

#### 2.0 Development of Workgroup Report

Not discussed.

#### 3.0 Legal Text Review

The Workgroup reviewed the legal text provided by National Grid. Nick Tyler joined the meeting for the discussion on the legal text.

JC made some general comments in relation to the status of the legal text. There were a number of references in the legal text using the words 'as soon as reasonably practicable' which were considered to be too open-ended as there should be a cut-off point.

JC sought clarification on how the Portal will fit in with the Capacity Indicator and the legal text as the Portal is not referenced in the UNC. MH asked if the Workgroup had discussed the Portal SLA?

#### New Action 0401: National Grid (NL) to clarify and confirm the status of the Portal.

NT sought Workgroup comments on the legal text provided for the meeting.

JC queried the gaps in the legal text indicated by the use of square brackets which need to be finalised to provide confirmation of timescales. NT confirmed these will be removed and the timescales added.

JC also expressed concern about the short timescales in relation to the PARCA Application. She sought assurance that the inclusion of an extra validation step is in addition to the existing rigour built into the current process.

Paragraph 1.19.4 (a) – should something be included in the Modification to indicate how many days National Grid will take to undertake their respective actions in relation to the process?

NT agreed that the timescales would be tidied up, the square brackets would be removed and that checks would be undertaken to ensure the Modification and legal text align. Consistency of terminology would also be checked.

Paragraphs 1.19.5 and 1.19.7 to be clarified further.

MH mentioned the Webex planned for 16 April to provide a walkthrough of the legal text. He stressed the importance of attending and confirmed that registration was via email to <u>Nicola.j.lond@nationalgrid.com</u>.

Workgroup highlighted the importance of the legal text reflecting the Modification and vice versa so an amended Modification and legal text is needed for the meeting on 16 April 2018.

A brief discussion took place on the rules of Capacity Indicator classification versus the Portal. For example, what is the process of getting a Capacity Indicator without a Portal, would a manual process be available?

BF suggested that a fair amount of work was still needed on the Modification to finalise it and suggested that the embedded document in the solutions section is attached separately to make it more accessible for readers.

The Workgroup also reviewed Section Y – Charging Methodologies in relation to the fees section. JC suggested that this section is reviewed once the Modification has been amended.

#### 4.0 Review of Outstanding Actions

Action 0102: National Grid NTS (NL) to provide information on how often National Grid NTS had accepted or declined non-obligated capacity requests in the past.

**Update:** MH reported that NL had provided long-term data but a request for short-term data had been received by the Operations department. MH sought clarification on whether this was still needed as it potentially involved 2 days of work. NK confirmed that this would be valuable data to the industry as it helps to support an assessment of risk for anyone not going down the PARCA route. As this Modification is due to report to the May Panel meeting it was agreed that this action would be transferred to the Transmission Workgroup. **Carried Forward to Transmission Workgroup** 

Action 0301: NL to update/amend the Modification to include the standard relevant objectives narrative (Action 0302 follows on from this).
