The current volume and unpredictability of UIG makes it difficult for Shippers to accurately calculate how much gas they should purchase in order to balance their positions. Given the materiality of this issue, we agree that, rather than the current fragmented approach, a step-change in focus and level of investment for UIG investigations is needed in the form of a task force and that the CDSP are best positioned to lead this work. This will provide resources to investigate the root causes of UIG, with a target of reducing its volatility and scale.

ASAP. We agree with the urgent status of this modification, given the materiality of current levels of UIG. The establishment of a task force has no systems implications and so any lead times following approval can be short.
