1.0 Introduction and Status Review

1.1 Approval of Minutes (03 October 2018)

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

2.0 Consideration of Amended Modification

No further amendments have been made to the Modification since the last review.

3.0 Review of Legal Text

Bob Fletcher (BF) showed onscreen the Legal Text provided and confirmed the aim is for the Workgroup to report to November UNC Panel.

Mark Perry (MP) advised that these proposals could be included in the Demand Estimation Methodology document (DEM) for approval at the next DESC meeting, 08 November 2018,

The Workgroup were then advised that, if DESC approve the change to the DEM, this Modification could be withdrawn

Tracey Saunders (TS) talked the Workgroup through the Legal Text provided as there were a number of questions to consider and it would be useful to have views should the Modification still be needed.

It was suggested that, paragraph 5.1.1 an alternative approach is that paragraphs c) and d) could be added in to a) (forecasting day ahead) and b) (historic). This would then be consistent with the provision of similar data items.

TS will take the suggestion back to their lawyer.

BF confirmed, the Legal Text has been provided within the 15 days, the amendments will only be completed if the Modification is to be progressed.

4.0 Review of the ROM

MP advised that even if the Modification is withdrawn the ROM analysis is still valid.

MP explained different considerations and said that it is unknown what the new formula will look like. Some of the costs in the high end are about temperature and wind; temperature is currently reported 2-hourly and wind 4-hourly, but this could be an opportunity to get temperature and wind on an hourly level to aid DESC and the CWV.

It was clarified that the intent is to make this reporting more flexible for the future. The highlevel costs incorporate adding in more flexibility.

Temperature and weighting are currently hard-coded, this is an opportunity to make them more flexible.

FC confirmed that the funding for this is 50-50 between Shippers and Transporters. This ROM will go to DSC Change Management Committee for them to decide on the best solution option, and whether to implement a cheap solution or to build in the flexibility.

5.0 Development of Workgroup Report

This will be covered at the next Workgroup meeting.

6.0 Review of Outstanding Actions

7.0 Next Steps

It was agreed to defer consideration until DESC had reviewed the DEM at which point, the Modification might be withdrawn.
