Re: UNC Modification Proposal 0652 – Introduction of Winter Read/Consumption Report and Associated Obligations

Thank you for the opportunity to provide representation on the above noted Modification Proposal. Please find below Northern Gas Network's (NGN) comments in respect of this Modification.

NGN supports this Modification proposal.

Reasons for Support/Opposition:

We agree that this modification should improve the accuracy of demand estimation by placing an obligation on Shippers to take all reasonable steps to ensure that accurate Winter Consumption Data is provided within key consumption calculation months, with the intention of preventing default Winter Annual Ratio (WAR) Bands from being assigned. As per the UIG Task force findings, this modification should also aid in a slight reduction in UIG

Implementation:

We agree that this modification could be implemented as soon as Authority approval is received, with the aim that this should allow the CDSP to create the reports in time for the Winter 2019/20 cycle
