- Consider whether short cycle Line-pack can fulfil the role of a storage product, and if so, its scope where Line-pack exists elsewhere
- Consider whether there is any quantified evidence of impact on Consumers
- Consider compliance with EU Law
- Assessment of alternative means to achieve objective
- Development of Solution (including business rules if appropriate)
- Identification of potential impacts on other energy codes
- Consideration of potential performance assurance impacts
- Assessment of potential impacts of the modification
- Assessment of implementation costs
- Assessment of legal text.

To produce a Workgroup Report, for submission to the UNC Modification Panel, containing the assessment and recommendation(s) of the Workgroup.
