New paragraph 11.1	To explain for the purposes of methodology when SoLR Customer Charges are payable.

New paragraph 11.2	Definition of 'Relevant Date' and 'Specified Amount' for purposes of paragraph 11.3.
New paragraph 11.3	To set out the basis for calculating the amounts within a valid claim which are recoverable in relation to domestic and non-domestic sites, either through notification from the Authority or (in default) on the basis of the site characteristics, i.e. the Domestic Component and the Non-domestic Component.
New paragraph 11.4	To explain the unit rate for the SoLR Customer Charge will be a function of the site characteristics, the relevant component of the Specified Amount and the aggregate peak day SOQ for relevant sites.
