Amendment to the Allocation of Entry Capacity and Flow Quantities to Qualifying CNCCD Routes

Introduction

This is an Individual Terms of Reference that includes matters referred from Panel or identified within any initial representations. It replaces the standard Terms of Reference.

Purpose of the Modification and its Solution

It is proposed that this Modification amends the apportionment of Entry Capacity and Entry Flow between multiple Conditional NTS Capacity Charge Discount qualifying routes that share an Entry Point, so that both are based on the minimum of the Exit Capacity and the Exit Flow at the Exit Point of each route.
