Consumer benefit	Reduced risk of entering into a gas supply emergency. If this was to occur, it could lead to increased bills for consumers and there is potential for interruption to their gas supply.
Other	Current timelines suggest that a UNC modification(s) will be raised in April 2023 following the conclusion of the UNC Request workgroups when we will have received and considered stakeholder feedback on barriers, risks, opportunities and potential solutions.
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
