New paragraph 5.9.1	Sets out the definition of what constitutes a 'Missing DRN'.
New paragraph 5.9.2	Sets out the steps to be taken by the CDSP following identification of a Missing DRN.

New paragraph 5.19	New sub-heading.
New paragraph 5.19.1	Sets out some new definitions used in paragraph 5.19, including the 'Effective Registration Date' being the date the CDSP is able to give effect to the Missing DRN under Section G5.9.2, and the 'Intended Registration Date', i.e. the registration date specified in the Missing DRN.
New paragraph 5.19.2	When a Missing DRN is identified the CDSP will estimate a Meter Reading for the Intended Registration Date using the existing rules on estimated meter readings.
New paragraph 5.19.3	Where meter reads exist either side of the Intended Registration Date the CDSP will use these for the purposes of deriving the estimated Meter Reading.

New paragraph 5.19.4	If the incoming and outgoing Users agree a different meter reading for the Intended Registration Date this will replace the CDSP's estimate.
New paragraph 5.19.5	<p>As soon as reasonably practicable after the last day m+3 following of the m in which the Effective Registration Date occurs, the CDSP will determine whether or not the metered quantity in the period between the Intended Registration Date and the Effective Registration Date exceeds the quantity specified in REC (currently 1,200 kWh).</p> <p>Where it does exceed this quantity, an adjustment will be made, so the incoming User and not the outgoing User is responsible for Transportation Charges from the Intended Registration Date. In the event the metered quantity is less than the relevant quantity no adjustment will be made, so that Transportation Charges from the Intended Registration Date remain with the outgoing User.</p>
New paragraph 5.19.6	No further adjustment will be made to Transportation Charges following the application of the rule in paragraph 5.19.5 by reason of later meter reads.
