New paragraph 32.2.1	New definitions for purposes of any required adjustment to Transportation Charges flowing from the CSS P1 Incident, including in particular 'applicable Intended Registration Date' and 'applicable Effective Registration Date', noting these dates differ in relation to non-compliant DRNs and re-submitted registration DRNs, and together define the relevant period for which Transportation Charges may be adjusted.

New paragraph 32.2.6	The CDSP will adjust the Transportation Charges so these are in all cases payable by the new RU from the applicable Intended Registration Date and it will tell the old and new RUs about the adjustment.
New paragraph 32.2.7	No other adjustment to that made under the previous rule will be made where other later meter readings are obtained for the adjustment period.
New paragraph 32.2.8	If both the old and new RU tell the CDSP before the last date of m+3 not to, the CDSP will not adjust Transportation Charges for the adjustment period.
